Social Identities Worksheet

This worksheet is designed to assist educators in raising their own awareness and that of students about social identities. Identities referenced include gender, sex, race, religion, sexual orientation, ability, age, national citizenship and origins, socio-economic class, body type/size, and Tribal or Indigenous affiliation. Examples of racial identities include Latinx, White, Black, Multiracial and Indigenous or Native American. The worksheet extends awareness-building about social identities by inviting reflection on the implications for self-understanding, supporting those who are members of marginalized groups, creating cultural change, and allyship.

REFLECTIVE QUESTIONS:

1. What social identities have you observed in your own school and within your own practice?

2. What are some implications of these observed social identities for you, your staff and your students?

3. How can your personal identity serve to inform and enrich your school and classroom environments?

4. What are some challenges educators should anticipate in implementing this worksheet in their classrooms?
