Throughout the day, school and system leaders from various provincial organizations and school districts focused on strengthening leadership capacity to deepen implementation of the Board Leadership Development Strategy and gathering expert advice from participating board teams on the Ontario Leadership Framework 2012. Congratulations for all your efforts and commitment.

Since the Institute for Education Leadership (IEL) launched the original Ontario Leadership Framework (OLF) in 2006, new research, conducted by Professor Emeritus Kenneth Leithwood, has emerged and professional leadership practices have been enhanced. As a result, the OLF 2012 now describes successful individual and organizational leadership practices for school and system level leaders. The IEL, in partnership with the Learning Environment Branch at the Ministry of Education, is coordinating a project that will assist school and system leaders with the implementation of the whole school approach to creating and maintaining a positive school climate. The IEL will engage key partner organizations in the development and dissemination of various support materials related to bullying prevention, and creating a culture of equity and inclusiveness, safe and caring schools.
